Accordingly, unit holders may receive credits for interest that are greater or lesser than the reported interest on Form 1099, depending upon the maturity dates of the funds' underlying securities. As a result, the fair market value of assets, which is not based on the income reported on Form 1099 but on the income credited to the custodial account, may be greater or lesser by a like amount.

Due to the foregoing adjustments, the Foundation is reporting a decrease of \$1,977 for CYE December 31, 2015.
