AMENDED AND RESTATED BYLAWS

OF

THE FRANKLIN P. AND ARTHUR W. PERDUE FOUNDATION, INC. ARTICLE I. DIRECTORS

Section 1. General Powers.

The business and affairs of The Franklin P. and Arthur W. Perdue Foundation, Inc. (the "Corporation") shall be managed under the direction of its Board of Directors. In addition to the powers expressly conferred upon them by these Amended and Restated Bylaws, the Board of Directors may exercise all the powers of the Corporation. From time to time, the Board of Directors may delegate to officers of the Corporation or other persons such powers and duties as it may see fit in addition to those specifically provided in these Amended and Restated Bylaws. The Board of Directors shall keep minutes of its meetings and a full account of its transactions.

Section 2. Number and Tenure.

The Board of Directors shall be comprised of five (5) voting members. Three (3) voting members will be selected through a process established by the Perdue Family Council (the "Family Council") that encourages multi-family, multi-generational representation on the Board of Directors. Two (2) of the voting members will be the Chief Executive Officer and Chief Financial Officer of Perdue Farms Inc. Each director shall be at least 25 years of age and hold office for a term of two (2) years and until a successor shall have been elected and qualify. The terms of the initial directors shall be staggered, in order to permit an ongoing orderly rotation of directors. A spouse of a Perdue family members may serve on the Board of Directors provided that he or she remains a spouse during his or her tenure on the Board.

Section 3. Regular Meetings.

A regular annual meeting of the Board of Directors shall be held during the first quarter of each calendar year, on a day and at a time and place to be determined by the President or the directors. Other regular meetings shall be held on such dates and at such times as may be designated from time to time by the President or by the directors. Each director shall endeavor to attend all regular and special meetings of the Board of Directors, as well as all committee meetings of those committees to which such director may be assigned. If a director misses more than one (1) Board meeting a year, the matter may be referred to the Family Council for information, review and possible action by the Family Council at the Family Council's discretion.

Section 4. Special Meetings.

Special meetings of the Board of Directors may be called by the President or by any one director.

Section 5. Place of Meetings.

The Board of Directors may hold its regular and special meetings at such place within or without the State of Maryland as it may from time to time determine. In

the absence of such determination, regular and special meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held at the principal business office of the Corporation.

Section 6. Notice.

Notice of the place, day and hour of every regular and special meeting shall be given to each director:

- a. By notice in writing, mailed postage prepaid, not later than the third day before the day set for the meeting and addressed to the director's last known post office address according to the records of the Corporation; or
- b. By telephonic or electronic communication or by notice in writing delivered personally or left at the director's residence or usual place of business not later than the second day before the day set for the meeting.

No notice of the time, place or purpose of any meeting need be given to any director who, in writing executed and filed with the records of the meeting either before or after the holding thereof, waives such notice or who attends the meeting.

Section 7. Quorum.

A majority of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business at every meeting. If at any meeting there be less than a quorum present, a majority of those present may adjourn the meeting from time to time, but not for a period in excess of 30 days, without notice other than by announcement at the meeting, until a quorum shall attend. At any such adjourned meeting at which a quorum shall be present, any business may be transacted which might have been transacted at the meeting as originally called. Except as otherwise provided in the Corporation's charter or these Amended and Restated Bylaws, the action of a majority of the directors present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the action of the Board of Directors.

Section 8. Vacancies.

Any vacancy occurring in the Board of Directors, or created by an increase in the number of directors, shall be filled by a majority of the remaining directors. A director elected to fill a vacancy shall be elected for the unexpired term of the predecessor in office.

Section 9. Resignation and Removal.

A director may resign at any time by notifying the President or Secretary of the Corporation in writing, specifying the effective date of the resignation. In the event that a director fails to specify the effective date of the resignation, such resignation shall become effective on its date of receipt. Any director may, by action of the Board of Directors, be removed from office, with or without cause, and another may be appointed by a majority of the remaining directors in the place of the person so removed to serve for the remainder of the term.

Section 10. Compensation.

Directors shall receive no compensation for their services as such but may, by resolution of the Board of Directors, be allowed reimbursement for their expenses actually and reasonably incurred on behalf of the Corporation.

Section 11. Informal Action by Directors.

Any action required or permitted to be taken at any meeting of the Board of Directors may be taken without a meeting, if a unanimous consent which sets forth the action is given in writing or by electronic transmission by each director and such is filed in paper or electronic form with the minutes of proceedings of the Board of Directors.

Section 12. Telephone Conference.

Members of the Board of Directors or any committee thereof may participate in a meeting of the Board or such committee by means of a conference telephone or similar communications equipment by means of which all persons participating in the meetings can hear each other at the same time and participation by such means shall constitute presence in person at the meeting.

ARTICLE II. GRANTMAKING

Section 1. In General.

The Corporation shall annually award grants consistent with the Corporation's charitable purposes and as required by law. Each year, the Board of Directors shall determine the amount to be distributed in furtherance of the Corporation's charitable purposes (the "Foundation Distributable Amount"); provided, however, that, the Foundation Distributable Amount shall not be less than the minimum amount required to be distributed in order to avoid the tax on undistributed income imposed by Section 4942 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), or any successor provision. In addition to and as part of the Foundation Distributable Amount, and in the manner set forth on **Exhibit A** hereto, as such exhibit may be amended from time to time, an amount will be determined each year to be awarded by the Perdue Family Lines (the "Family Distributable Amount"). For purposes of this provision, the "Perdue Family Lines" are Sandra Spedden and her lineal descendants; Anne Oliviero and her lineal descendants; Beverly Jennings and her lineal descendants; and James Perdue and his lineal descendants. From the Foundation Distributable Amount, grants shall be awarded as follows:

- a. The Board of Directors and the Grants Committee, pursuant to the provisions of, and in the manner set forth in, these Amended and Restated Bylaws, shall designate the recipient(s) for the annual Foundation Distributable Amount less any amounts designated pursuant to subparagraph b below.
- b. The Perdue Family Lines shall designate the recipient(s) for the Family Distributable Amount in accordance with **Exhibit A** hereto.
- c. In the event that one or more of the Perdue Family Lines fails to designate, pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph b above, the recipient(s) for the entire portion of their share of the annual Family Distributable Amount by December 1 of each calendar year, such undesignated portion shall revert to the Corporation and be designated by the Board of Directors and the Grants Committee, pursuant to the provisions of subparagraph a above.

Section 2, Eligible Grantees.

For purposes of this Article II, eligible recipients of grants shall be such domestic organizations exempt from federal income tax pursuant to Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and classified as public charities pursuant to any of Section 509(a)(1), (2), or (3) of the Code; provided, however, that if the Board of Directors determines, in its reasonable discretion, that a proposed grant is incompatible with the purposes of the Corporation, the Board of Directors may disallow the issuance of such proposed grant. The Corporation shall also not award any grants that give rise to self-dealing pursuant to Treasury Regulation Section 53.4941(d)-2(f)(1).

ARTICLE III. OFFICERS

Section 1. In General.

The officers of the Corporation shall consist of a President, a Secretary, and a Treasurer, and whenever deemed advisable by the Board, one or more Vice-Presidents, Assistant Secretaries or Assistant Treasurers.

The Chief Executive Officer of Perdue Farms Inc. shall serve as President of the Corporation and the Chief Financial Officer of Perdue Farms Inc. shall serve as Treasurer and Secretary of the Corporation. All other officers of the Corporation shall be elected by the Board of Directors. The terms of office of all officers shall be for one year or for such longer term as shall be designated by the Board of Directors, or until a successor shall have been duly elected, unless the officer's tenure is sooner terminated by incapacity to serve, resignation, or removal. Any two offices, except those of President and Vice-President, may be held by the same person, but no officer shall execute, acknowledge or verify any instrument in more than one capacity when such instrument is required to be executed, acknowledged or verified by any two or more officers. The Board of Directors may from time to time appoint such other agents and employees, with such powers and duties as the Board may deem proper.

Section 2. President.

The President shall be the Chief Executive Officer of the Corporation and shall, when present, preside at all meetings of the directors. The President shall have general management and direction of the activities of the Corporation and all powers ordinarily exercised by the president of a corporation; shall have authority to employ an administrator or other persons at salaries fixed by resolution of the Board of Directors to assist in the general management and direction of the activities of the Corporation; and shall have authority to sign and execute, in the name of the Corporation, all deeds, mortgages, bonds, contracts or other instruments to be executed on the Corporation's behalf.

Section 3. Vice-President.

In the absence of the President or in the event of his or her inability or refusal to act, the Vice-President (or in the event there be more than one Vice-President, the Vice-Presidents in the order of their election or designated seniority) shall perform the duties of the President and, when so acting, shall have and may exercise all the powers of the President. Any Vice-President shall perform such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or by the Board of Directors.

Section 4. Secretary.

The Secretary shall keep minutes of the meetings of the Board of Directors, see that all notices are duly given in accordance with the provisions of these Amended and Restated Bylaws or as required by law, be custodian of the corporate records and of the seal of the Corporation, and in general perform all duties incident to the office of secretary and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or by the Board of Directors.

Section 5. Treasurer.

If required by the Board of Directors, the Treasurer shall give a bond for the faithful discharge of the duties of the office in such sum and with such surety or sureties as the Board of Directors shall determine, the cost of which shall be borne by the Corporation. The Treasurer shall have charge and custody of all funds and securities of the Corporation, receive and give receipts for monies due to the Corporation, and deposit all such monies in the name of the Corporation in such banks or other depositories as shall from time to time be selected by the Board of Directors. In general, the Treasurer shall perform all the duties incident to the office of treasurer and such other duties as from time to time may be assigned by the President or by the Board of Directors.

Section 6. Assistant Officers.

Each Assistant Secretary and Assistant Treasurer (if any) shall hold office for such period and shall have such authority and perform such duties as the Board of Directors may prescribe.

Section 7. Compensation.

No officers shall receive any compensation for their services as such but may, by resolution of the Board of Directors, be allowed reimbursement for their expenses actually and reasonably incurred on behalf of the Corporation.

Section 8. Resignation and Removal.

An officer may resign at any time by notifying the President or Secretary of the Corporation in writing, specifying the effective date of the resignation. The Board of Directors shall have the power to set the term of any officer and at any regular or special meeting to remove any officer with or without cause. The Board may authorize any officer to remove subordinate officers.

Section 9. Vacancies.

The Board of Directors at any regular or special meeting shall have the power to fill a vacancy occurring in any officership.

ARTICLE IV. COMMITTEES

Section 1. Executive Committee of Directors.

The Board of Directors, by resolution adopted by a majority of the directors in office, may designate from among its members an Executive Committee consisting of such number of directors as may be specified in the resolution, which Committee, to the extent provided in such resolution, shall have and exercise the authority of the Board of Directors in the management of the Corporation, except that such Committee shall have no authority to amend, alter, or repeal the bylaws of the Corporation; to elect, appoint or remove any officer of the Corporation; or to approve any document required to be filed with the State Department of Assessments and Taxation of Maryland.

Section 2. Grants Committee.

The Corporation shall also maintain a Grants Committee which shall be charged with approving all grants less than \$50,000 awarded from that portion of the Foundation Distributable Amount described in Article II, Section 1. The Grants Committee shall also consider grants greater than \$50,000 and, if such proposed grant in excess of \$50,000 is approved by the Grants Committee, the Grants Committee shall recommend such grants to the Board of Directors for its consideration and approval. The Grants Committee shall be comprised of seven (7) voting members. Up to five (5) voting members will be selected through a process established by the Family Council that encourages multi-family, multi-generational representation on the Grants Committee. Two (2) of the voting members will be the Chief Executive Officer and Senior Vice President, Human Resources, of Perdue Farms Inc. In order to encourage broad participation and effective governance, family members serving as a director of the Corporation will not be eligble to serve on the Grants Committee. It is anticipated that the Grants Committee will hold regular meetings on a quarterly basis as it may from time to time determine.

Section 3. Other Committees.

The Board of Directors may by resolution constitute and appoint such other committees to perform such other duties and functions as the Board may deem appropriate.

Section 4. Term of Office.

Each member of every committee shall continue in office at the pleasure of the Board of Directors.

Section 5. Chairman.

One member of each committee shall be appointed chairman, either directly by the Board of Directors or in such other manner as the Board of Directors may prescribe.

Section 6. Quorum.

Unless otherwise provided in the resolution of the Board of Directors designating a committee, a majority of the whole committee shall constitute a quorum and the act of a majority of the members present at a meeting at which a quorum is present shall be the act of the committee.

Section 7. Rules.

Each committee may adopt rules for its own governance not inconsistent with the Corporation's charter, these Amended and Restated Bylaws, rules adopted by the Board of Directors, or any applicable law of the State of Maryland.

ARTICLE V. CONTRACTS, CHECKS, DEPOSITS AND GIFTS

Section 1. Contracts.

The Board of Directors may authorize any officer or officers, or other agent or agents of the Corporation, in addition to the officers so authorized by these Amended and Restated Bylaws, to enter into any contract or execute and deliver any instrument in the name of and on behalf of the Corporation, and such authority may be general or confined to specific instances.

Section 2. Checks, Drafts, Etc.

All checks, drafts or orders for the payment of money, notes or other evidences of indebtedness issued in the name of the Corporation shall be signed by such officer or officers, or agent or agents, of the Corporation, and in such manner as shall from time to time be determined by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 3. Deposits.

All funds of the Corporation shall be deposited from time to time to the credit of the Corporation in such banks or other depositories as the Board of Directors may select.

Section 4. Gifts.

The Board of Directors may accept on behalf of the Corporation any contribution, gift, bequest or devise for the general purposes or for any special purpose of the Corporation.

ARTICLE VI. SUNDRY PROVISIONS

Section 1. Fiscal Year.

The fiscal year of the Corporation shall be the calendar year, unless some other fiscal year be specified by resolution of the Board of Directors.

Section 2. Seal.

The seal of the Corporation shall be circular in form with the name of the Corporation inscribed around the outer edge, and in the center shall be inscribed the word "Maryland" and the year of incorporation. In lieu of affixing the corporate seal to any document, it shall be sufficient to meet the requirements of any law, rule, or regulation relating to a corporate seal to affix the word "(SEAL)" adjacent to the signature of the authorized officer of the Corporation.

Section 3. Indemnification.

To the maximum extent permitted by the Maryland General Corporation Law and the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as from time to time amended, the Corporation shall indemnify its currently acting and its former directors, officers, agents and employees to the full extent required by the Corporation's charter.

Section 4. Amendments to Bylaws.

These Amended and Restated Bylaws may be altered, amended or repealed, and new bylaws may be adopted, by the vote or written assent of at least four of the five voting members of the Board of Directors; provided, however, that $\underline{Exhibit\ A}$ hereto shall be amended only in the manner set forth on $\underline{Exhibit\ A}$.

EXHIBIT A

PERDUE FAMILY LINE GRANTMAKING PROCEDURES

Funds held in the Corporation that were received for the redemption of shares that the Corporation previously held in Franklin P. Perdue Inc. are available for charitable purposes in equal amounts by each of the Perdue Family Lines. All charitable gift giving for each of the Perdue Family Lines shall be administered in the following manner:

1. Annual Awards

- a. During the first quarter of each calendar year, the Treasurer shall prepare and distribute to Sandra Spedden ("Sandra"), Anne Oliviero ("Anne"), Beverly Jennings ("Beverly"), and James Perdue ("James" and, together with Sandra, Anne, and Beverly, the "G3s") the minimum Family Distribution Amount in regards to the above-referenced funds for the then current calendar year. Such determination will be made in accordance with the Code in regards to the above-referenced funds considering the average of prior year balances including any contributions made and the gains and loses of any investment activity.
- b. A meeting of the G3s will be scheduled to review the minimum requirements and confirm agreement on the amount of the Family Distribution Amount for the then current calendar year.
- c. The Family Distribution Amount agreed to will require the agreement of a majority of the G3s by either vote or written consent and the Family Distribution Amount so chosen will be at least equal to the minimum Family Distribution Amount determined pursuant to and in accordance with 1.a. above.

2. Grantmaking

- a. All grants awared must comply with the provisions of these Amended and Restated Bylaws.
- b. No grants per grantee receipient shall be less than \$1,000 and each Perdue Family Line is limited to no more than five (5) such \$1,000 grants per calendar year. However, larger grant amounts are encouraged to promote efficient and impactful gift giving and each Perdue Family line shall use their best efforts to target total gift giving within the range of 20-25 grants per Perdue Family Line per calendar year.

3. Perdue Family Line Rights

- a. For so long each G3 is willing and able to exercise such rights, each G3 shall exercise the grantmaking rights attributed to his or her Perdue Family Line.
- b. At such time as any G3 is no longer able or willing to exercise the grantmaking rights attributed to his or her Perdue Family Line, the authority to exercise such rights of such Perdue Family Line shall pass in equal shares to the children ("G4s") of such G3s.
- c. Any amendments to this Exhibit A shall be made only pursuant to the unanimous vote or written consent of the G3s; provided, however, that in the event that one or more of the G3s is no longer able or willing to exercise his or her rights hereunder, the voting rights of such G3 shall be exercised by a majority of the G4s that succeeded to the rights of such G3.
 - i. By way of example: If during a year when each Perdue Family Line was permitted to designate the recipients of one or more gifts totaling \$150,000 and one of the G3s, who has three children (G4s) was no longer able or willing to exercise his or her rights hereunder:
 - a. Each of the three G3s willing to exercise his or her rights hereunder would be entitled to designate the recipients of one or more gifts totaling \$150,000;
 - b. Each of the G4s of the one G3 not willing or unable to exercise his or her rights hereunder would be entitled to designate the recipients of one or more gifts for a proportional share of that year's amount. In this example, each G4 would be entitled to designate recipients of one or more gifts totaling 1/3 of the total amount of \$150,000, or \$50,000 each; and
 - c. In this example, any amendments to this Exhibit A shall be made only with the (i) unanimous vote or written consent of the three G3s who exercised his or her rights hereunder, and (ii) at least two of the three G4s of the one G3 who was not willing or was unable to exercise his or her rights hereunder.
