This trust was established under the Will of Forest L. Garrison, who died in 1934. This Will provides that 80% of the net income of the trust shall be distributed annually to the Borough of Shickshinney, Pennsylvania, and that the remaining 20% of net income shall be added to the principal of the trust.

Subsection 10(1)(3) of the Tax Reform Act of 1969 provides that:

In the case of organizations organized before May 27, 1969, Section 4942 shall **** (B) not apply to an organization to the extent its income is required to be accumulated pursuant to the mandatory terms (as in effect on May 27, 1969, and at all times thereafter) of an instrument executed before May 27, 1969, with respect to the transfer of income producing property to such organization. *****. With respect to taxable years beginning after December 31, 1971, subparagraph (B) **** shall apply only during the pendency of any judicial proceeding by the private foundation which is necessary to reform or to excuse such foundation from compliance with, its governing instrument ***** in order to comply with the provisions of Section 4942 **** and in the case of subparagraph (B) for all periods after the termination of such judicial proceeding during which the governing instrument or any other instrument does not permit compliance with such provisions.

A judicial proceeding was instituted in 1971 in the Circuit Court of Kanawha County, West Virginia, to reform the terms of the Garrison Trust. The Court denied the Trustee permission to amend the Will to eliminate the provisions requiring the retention and reinvestment of twenty percent of the income from the trust estate. A copy of the decree of the Circuit Court of Kanawha County was attached to the return filed for the Trust on Form 5227 for the year 1977.

Accordingly, Trust U/W Forest L. Garrison is not subject to the tax imposed by Section 4942 for the year 2015 because of calculating its required distributions based on 80% of its income as opposed to 100%.
