THE FOUNDATION CAN MAKE ADVISORY RECOMMENDATIONS FOR DISTRIBUTIONS FROM THE DONOR ADVISED FUNDS, BUT CFGA RETAINS THE ULTIMATE AUTHORITY AND CONTROL OVER THE FUND.
