RMRPI and brought a balance with their program. The next largest contributor was \$14,323 in conference registrations for Bridging the Divid
which is a 3 day program for Suicide Prevention The remaining amount of \$12,577 was for nominal registration costs for students to attend
the 3 week Aurora Youth 4 Success program and reimbursements from programs.
Part I - 10 Grants and similar amounts paid \$(95,511). The largest portion of the grants paid was for a distribution to the Suicide Prevention
Coalition of Colorado (SPCC) for \$(59,129) when this program established their own 501c3 and became an independent program. These fund
were transferred from the RMRPI assets to help them establish their new organization. The balance of the funds \$(36,382) were distributed
to 22 non-profit organizations in the state of Colorado that provide programs for children or injury prevention programs. These organizations
apply for funds to the RMRPI Board of Directors and must be a 501c3 in good standing with the State of Colorado to apply for these funds.
The funds were generated through the Santa Claus Pub Crawl and Colorado Kids 1st license plate program.
Part I - 16 Other Expenses: \$(41,212). The largest expense \$(12,235) are conference/ travel related associated with the Bridging the Divide.
The second largest expense is \$(3,666) for food and beverage associated with lunches served and meals prepared in cooking classes at
the Aurora Youth 4 Success program. \$(3,465) we due to credit card processing, accounting fees, and banking fees. The remaining expense
is for small categories such as interest fees, software purchases, office supplies, building security, and a new PC for the organization.
