The purpose of the ILOA is to expand human understanding of the cosmos through observation from the moon.

In 2015, ILOA was involved in the following activities:

- ILOA conducted a series of 8 International Galaxy forums for educators, students, and astronomers. Forums were held in the following locations:
  - Bandung, Indonesia (February 21, 2015);
  - Bangkok, Thailand (February 24, 2015);
  - Santa Clara, California (July 3, 2015);
  - Hutchinson, Kansas (August 29, 2015);
  - Beijing, China (September 9, 2015);
  - Vancouver, Canada (September 26, 2015);
  - Kamuela, Hawaii (November 12, 2015); and
  - Scarsdale, New York (December 4, 2015).

The purpose of the forums is to advance general science education throughout the world. These events support school teachers, students and the general public by advancing 21<sup>st</sup>-Century galaxy education. Materials for the Galaxy Forums were produced and distributed to educators including educational Galaxy Posters that display statistics and information about the Galaxy. Presentations topics included:

- New Horizons and the Pluto System
- Exploring Galaxies From the Moon
- Measuring the Radio Signatures of the Early Universe
- Archeoastronomy and Cultural Importance of the Moon
- Making Moon South Pole Astronomy and Communications a Reality
- Applying Hawaii Astrophysics Leadership to 21<sup>st</sup> Century Frontiers

- In 2015, ILOA worked on advancing a grant to build a Research and Education Center in Kamuela, HI. Once constructed, the Center will be an important education and science resource for the community.
- In 2012, ILOA conducted scientific research on their proposed instrument for a lunar mission with Intek (of Canada) and Moon Express (of California). As a result of these studies, in May of 2013, ILOA unveiled flight test hardware for the first private telescope that will be launched to the Moon. Moon Express will be sending a series of robotic missions to the Moon which will carry a shoebox-sized telescope to test the ILOA's software and hardware on the moon. The telescope is scheduled to be launched by 2018.
- ILOA began participation in a Human Lunar Lander Study with Golden Spike Company in December 2012. This study is still under way.
