Part XV Supplemental Information, Line 2(d) - Restrictions or limitations on awards, such as by geographical areas, charitable fields, kinds of institutions, or other factors:

The December 29, 1988 resolution for the Board of Trustees, that creates the Selection Committee, defines the permissible uses of scholarship or grant money received by an individual and requires a reporting to the Foundation concerning the use of funds received from the Marti Foundation,

Permissible uses of the scholarship or grant funds are limited to the following:

1. Payment of tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance of the recipient at an Approved School as a candidate for a degree at an Approved School.
2. Payment of fees, books, supplies and equipment required for courses of instruction at an Approved School,
3. If the award so designates, payment of reasonable expenses of accommodations, such as room, board, laundry services and similar services, travel, research and clerical help incident to pursuing the recipient's studies at an Approved School (and actually expended during the term of the award or within a reasonable time before or after that term).

Funds an individual receives from the Foundation in excess of the amount spent for permissible uses shall be returned to the Foundation (or applied against future awards to that individual). Reports describing the expenditure of grant or scholarship funds are to be submitted to the Foundation within one (1) month after the completion of each semester or trimester of study. Such report shall be a written report including a financial accounting for the entire amount of the scholarship or grant, information on whether the recipient is maintaining satisfactory academic progress (to include a copy of grade reports for each semester or trimester for which scholarship or grant funds were received)) and such other information as the Foundation may reasonably require.

An "Approved School" is an educational organization that normally maintains a regular facility and curriculum and normally has a regularly enrolled body of pupils or students in attendance at the place where its educational activities are regularly carried on, within the meaning of Section 197 (b) (1) (A) (ii) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 or corresponding section of any future federal tax code, other than an organization that the Board has provided, by resolution, shall not be an Approved School.

MEMORANDUM AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
HILL COLLEGE
AND
MARTI FOUNDATION

This Memorandum Agreement (the "Agreement") is made effective as of December 30, 2015, by and between Hill College (the "College"), a not-for-profit governmental/educational institution of the State of Texas, and the Marti Foundation (the "Foundation"), a Texas non-profit corporation.

WHEREAS, many of the College's students are from Johnson County, Texas (the "County");

WHEREAS, the Foundation wishes to distribute funds to the College to be used to provide scholarships (the College's "Marti Foundation Scholarships") for such of the College's students who are from the County as the College selects under the terms of this Agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PREMISES, the parties hereto agree as follows:

1. Gifts.

A. Initial gift.

The Foundation herewith gives the College the sum of Four Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$400,000) in cash. The College agrees to endow (for the sole purpose of providing future scholarships that will be subject to this Agreement) no more than Eighty Thousand Dollars (\$80,000) of this initial gift, and to distribute the rest of this initial gift (at least \$320,000) as scholarships on or before July 31, 2017.

B. Additional gifts from the Foundation.

The College and the Foundation contemplate that the Foundation may, from time to time, choose to make additional gifts in cash to the College. At the time any such gift is made, the Foundation may designate in writing that the gift is made subject to this Agreement, the maximum amount of any such gift the College may endow, and the date by which the College must distribute the rest of any such gift as scholarships.

C. Gifts from others.

With express prior written permission from the Foundation, the College has the right but not the obligation to permit other individuals and entities to make gifts to the College that are also subject to this Agreement.

2. Criteria for scholarship grants to students. The College agrees to select scholarship recipients from among its students who satisfy the following (the "Criteria"):

A. The Foundation requires:

(i) Either

(a) The student graduated from or is currently attending a high school (which may be a home school) located in the County, or

(b) The student has worked or resided in the County for at least one year;

(ii) The student takes (through the College) one or more technical and/or academic classes (as opposed to community education classes), including without limitation one or more dual credit courses at a high school (which may be a home school) located in the County; and

(iii) The student must not be a child or grandchild of George W. Marti or Jo C. Marti.

B. The College may establish minimum standards for:

(i) Past academic performance.

(ii) Performance on SAT, ACT, and tests designed to measure ability and aptitude for higher education.

C. The College may consider:

(i) Recommendations from instructors and other individuals who are not related to the applicant.

(ii) Financial need.

(iii) Conclusions drawn from personal interviews as to motivation and character.

(iv) With respect to reapplications of successful applicants, the maintenance of scholastic standards.

(v) Such other criteria (the use of which is not otherwise prohibited by the College's articles of incorporation, bylaws, corporate resolutions, policies and procedures, or applicable law) as the College may determine from time to time to be helpful in making objective, well-reasoned decisions.

D. The College must not consider:

(i) Race.

(ii) Color.

(iii) National origin.

(iv) Ethnic origin.

(v) Sex.

(vi) Such other factors the College is prohibited from considering for financial aid purposes under the College's articles of incorporation, bylaws, corporate resolutions, policies and procedures, or applicable law.

(vii) Current service, prior service, nor potential for future service of the student or of any related person with Marti Electronics, Inc.; Marti, Inc.; Marti Charolais; Marti Farms; STL, Inc.; Marti Foundation; or any other activity or entity that is or was established or controlled by George W. Marti, Jo C. Marti, or any of their descendants.

3. Establishment and use of the Fund. The College agrees:

A. To invest gifts received from the Foundation pursuant to this Agreement in one or more accounts (the "Fund") owned by the College but designated as being the Marti Foundation Scholarship Fund.

B. To select, from time to time, from among the College's students who then meet the Criteria, the specific students ("Marti Scholars") who will receive scholarships from the Fund and the amounts of each scholarship.

C. To use the Fund (including income from the portions of the Fund that the College endows) solely to provide scholarships for the College's Marti Scholars.

D. To the extent permitted under applicable law, to not permit any Marti Scholar's financial aid (other than possibly loans) from sources outside the Fund to be reduced because of any scholarship awarded under this Agreement.

4. Scholarship selection and permissible scholarship uses.

A. The College's website has an electronic scholarship application (which currently closes annually in June). Dual credit students do need to apply to the College and do have access to the electronic scholarship application. The College sends completed electronic scholarship applications to the College's internal college scholarship review committee, and that committee selects the students who will receive various scholarships that the College administers. That committee will select the Marti Scholars and determine the amounts of their scholarships.

B. The College will notify awardees by August of each academic year. Scholarship funds may only be used (i) for the student's tuition and fees required for enrollment or attendance at the College, and (ii) for fees, books, supplies, and equipment required for courses of instruction at the College, within the meaning of Internal Revenue Code Section 117. Award amounts may vary based on factors such as the financial need and the number of academic hours taken by each student, but will not exceed the College's published cost of attendance for that academic year.

C. The Foundation's Board of Trustees may change the scholarship selection procedure if it desires; however, changes to the selection procedure will only become effective at the end of that academic year.

D. The College may make reasonable adjustments to its usual scholarship selection procedure if it chooses to award Marti Foundation Scholarships for Spring 2016 and/or Summer 2016.

5. Scholarship Agreement Approval. By signing below, the Foundation is signifying that it agrees with the established Criteria and selection procedure. It acknowledges that it may alter the Criteria or selection procedure at the beginning of each scholarship period, which occurs annually in the spring.

6. Fund administration and reports. The College will administer and control all property of the Fund and will make distributions therefrom to or for the benefit of Marti Scholars in accordance with this Agreement, the College's articles of incorporation, bylaws, corporate resolutions, policies and procedures, and applicable law. The parties hereto acknowledge that the College does not have trust powers and agree that the Fund shall be held as property of the College in its corporate capacity and shall not be deemed to be a trust fund held by it in any fiduciary capacity. The College will maintain appropriate records regarding the administration of the Fund and distributions therefrom, and will provide reports to the Foundation at least semiannually, and also as reasonably requested by the Foundation.

7. Termination. Each of the College and the Foundation has the right to unilaterally terminate this Agreement upon ninety (90) days' prior written notice delivered to the non-terminating party at the address referenced below the signature of the non-terminating party. In the event of a termination, the College will continue to select and administer scholarships to Marti Scholars until all funds (including funds that had previously been designated as endowed) given to the College under this Agreement are depleted. Otherwise, upon such termination, all understandings set forth above shall cease.


8. General. Except as expressly provided herein to the contrary, this Agreement contains a complete expression of the understanding between the College and the Foundation and cannot be modified nor amended without the written consent of both parties; provided, however, that any court of proper jurisdiction and venue may strike, amend, or otherwise reform any provision of this Agreement as reasonably necessary to make the Agreement enforceable and/or to protect the status of the Foundation as an organization described in Internal Revenue Code Section 501(c)(3). The parties agree that any inadvertent violation of this Agreement that might endanger the Foundation's tax status will be corrected promptly after it has come to the attention of the party that has the ability to correct the violation. This Agreement inures to the benefit of the parties' successors and assigns. Paragraph headings are for convenience of reference only and shall not be considered in construing this Agreement. The parties agree that this Agreement is to be performed in Johnson County, Texas, that it is to be construed under the internal laws of the State of Texas (without giving effect to the choice-of-law principles thereof), and that jurisdiction and venue in any action concerning this Agreement may be had in Johnson County, Texas.
