	lifestyles of citizens in 2014. We collected clothes, blankets, can food, arranged medical support, makeshift shelter, water, transport-
	ation and overall relief for victims and their communities. We mobilized volunteers to help with the clean up, provide warm food to
	victims and their communities. We partnered with other humanitarian agencies to provide needed services and support in the United
	States, and elsewhere after the massive hurricane disasters, Colorado for the wild fire that swept through the place, California victims
	of draught and mudslide, flooding in Upper Midwest, drought in Texas, Tornadoes in Alabama, and fire disaster in Southwest and
	Midwestern states, including the Ohio valley. Overseas we provided for victims of earthquakes, draught, wars, refugees, in Africa,
	Midddle East (Syria, Jordan), C.A.R, we provided relief to thousands of families after the floodings in Europe, South America, India, and the Typhoon devastations in the Philippines.

	THE INTERNATIONAL HABITAT PROJECT: This project started in 2010 with grants from EU, Asian, participating African nations, and
	grants from private Foundations. The project major goal is to provide low accommodation for families, the homeless, Veterans from
	civil wars in Africa and elsewhere who are transiting into civilian life by giving them accommodation, training, and readiness to be
	productive citizens. The program also benefits struggling families and refugees with transient or permanent accommodation.
	The International Habitat Project replicates The Hope Habitat Project in the United States of America - an experimental transient
	project we started in 2010 in 7 States. During the 2014 program year, the project helped more than 11500 families in 1400 locations around the world.
	The all-around program takes 3-6 months for its participants during which they are exposed to job interviews, guided to start their
	own small businesses, or be ready to work in any industry. The project also offers drug and alcohol detox programs to individuals
	with drug and alcohol problems. Graduates receive initial living support - furnitures, mobile homes, utility payments and basic living
	necessities until they secure gainful employment to stand on their own.

	THE HEALTH & EDUCATION PROJECT is a worldwide project aimed at enhancing health and education in Third world countries. The
	project is funded and spearheaded with resources from European and other health grants for developing nations. In the phase 3 of
	the project, resources are directed toward aggressive Malaria prevention, HIV /Aids containment, measles immunization, pre-natal
	treatment, general health counseling and increasing education centers in rural areas in beneficiary countries. As of 2014, the project
	has trained over 26750 medical professionals and technicians, and 19325 educators. The program distributed 77 Mobile clinics, built
	and refurbished more than 884 schools, distributed over 6,376,025 tents, trained 12,000 volunteers through the 2014 program year, and distributed medicines, medical supplies, and educational supplies in over 120 countries.
	Special challenges arose in this year with the Ebola virus breakout and containment in West Africa. We dovoted extra resources for
	and education in various communities in addition to supplies and building quarantine centers.
