	MLR worked with numerous (over 50) landowners in 2015 to permanently protect their private lands for continued agricultural
	production, open space, and natural habitat. Ten of these landowners donated/sold conservation easements to MLR that protected
	over 14,800 acres, including 377 additional acres in the Greater Yellowstone Ecosystem bordering Yellowstone National Park. Nearly
	18 miles of river/stream frontage on some of Montana's blue ribbon trout fisheries were protected in perpetuity. Over fifty percent
	(50%) of the easements completed in 2015 were adjacent to or within 5 miles of properties already protected by conservation
	easements. MLR is creeping ever so close to that 1,000,000 acres of land protected as of 12/31/15 easements protected over
	958,348 acres of agricultural/recreational lands in Montana. That acreage includes crop, hay, and pasture lands; range/forest lands;
	stream frontage, elk habitat; and wetlands. See Schedule O for a complete list of projects & expenses.

original donor of the easement, it was discovered that the original easement document erroneously included a portion of land that was not
owned by the donor at the time of the easement donation or at the time of his death due to an inaccurate certificate of survey. To settle
Mr. Hamilton's estate the error was corrected in the public records by the completion of the Correction to Deed of Conservation Easement
that accurately described the property under the easement.
2) V-O Ranch (Lyndes Property) The original Deed of Conservation Easement on the Lyndes Property utilized an incorrect legal description
when it was recorded on December 23, 2002, as Document No. 3031980, in Lewis and Clark County public records. The error in the warranty
deed and the Deed of Conservation Easement were not discovered until 2015 after the Lyndes family transferred ownership of the property
to V-O Ranch, LLC, and wanted to sell the entire easement property. Ultimately there were approximately 25 acres of the Lyndes property
that were omitted from the original easement that the family members intended to include under the easement. The legal description for
the 204-acre property was corrected in the warranty deed and in the easement prior to the sale of the property. The Correction to
Deed of Conservation Easement was recorded on April 7, 2015, as Document No. 3271028, Book M49, page 6806; and re-recorded on April 10,
2015, as Document No. 3271159, Book M49, page 6929 due to a typographic error when referencing the original deed.
3) Skogen Property – This 610-acre property is located approximately 1.5 miles from Fort Shaw, Montana, on the Sun River. This property
was subdivided in approximately 2008 into 20+ lots; thankfully none of the lots sold and the Skogen family purchased the property. On
December 22, 2014, the Skogens donated a Deed of Conservation Easement (recorded as Doc. No. R030-0319, records of Cascade County,
Montana) that restricted the sale of the property to one parcel only. The legal description in the original easement document erroneously
omitted three of the lots. Via that certain Correction to Deed of Conservation Easement, recorded on May 6, 2015, those three additional
lots were included in the protection of the property as the family originally intended.
Restatement/Amendment:
1) South Jack Creek Ranch This property in the Madison Valley near Ennis, MT, was first protected by a Deed of Conservation Easement
donated in 1996. In 2011, the subsequent landowner purchased an additional 516 acres bordering the property that was incorporated
into the easement by a "Restatement of Deed of Conservation Easement and Grant Deed of Conservation Easement on Additional Lands"
