



In order to account for any uncertain tax positions, the Medical Center and Foundation determine whether it is more likely than not that a tax position will be sustained upon examination of the technical merits of the position, assuming the taxing authority has full knowledge of all information If the tax position does not meet the more likely than not recognition threshold, the benefit of the tax position is not recognized in the financial statements. The Medical Center is also engaged, to a limited extent, in activities which the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) considers unrelated to the Medical Center's exempt purpose, and therefore, taxable These activities, however, have resulted in net operating losses for income tax purposes. The Medical Center does not presently anticipate that a tax benefit from these net operating losses will be realized in the future Accordingly, any potential deferred tax asset resulting from the availability of net operating loss carry-forward is offset by a valuation allowance of equal amount No deferred tax assets and liabilities have been recognized since no other differences exist between the financial and tax basis of reporting the Medical Center's assets and liabilities. The Medical Center recorded no assets or liabilities for uncertain tax positions Federal returns for the tax years 2012 and beyond remain subject to examination by the IRS


