Although local tourist attractions draw a steady influx of visitors of over 2+ million annually and generate substantial local revenues, Grand County's rural location and low industrial diversity has impeded the development of major growth drivers outside of tourism. Unemployment in the County exceeds. Utah and U.S. level, and the lack of high paying industries corresponds to below average household income levels. The median age of Grand County's population is 39.4 years compared with Utah's population at 29.5 years and the U.S. figure of 36.8 years. Annual average household income for Grand County is \$50,331, compared with \$68,450 and \$67,315 for Utah and the U.S. respectively. Approximately 32% of the County's households' income levels fall under \$25,000 threshold. Educationally, 29.9% are high school graduates, 30.3% have completed.
