- Pt IV Sec C Ln 1 The Foundation does not have an overlapping majority of its governing board with the governing board of North Carolina State University ("NCSU"), which is a public university that is within the class of other supported organizations that are designated by class or purpose rather than by name in the Foundation's articles of incorporation. The IRS regulations require that a Type II supporting organization must establish the common control relationship with one or more of the supported organizations. Reg. Sections 1.509(a)-4(d)(2). A majority of the Foundation's trustees also constitute a majority of the trustees of Clayton. The presence of this common supervision and control among their respective governing bodies ensures both that the Foundation will be responsive to the needs and requirements of Clayton and that the control and management of the Foundation is vested in the same persons that control and manage Clayton.
