Combined together: \$1,601,930 4d Other Program Services: Community Impact - United Way continues to measurably improve lives of people in our community by funding critical programs and working with community partners to tackle the toughest health and human service issues in Pierce County. We lead, support and invest in community efforts to ensure all of our children are prepared to succeed in school and in life. By 2024, in collaboration with community partners, we will break the cycle of intergenrational poverty among Pierce County's most vulnerable families and children by removing barriers and focusing on long term solutions. We will foucs on the following areas in Pierce County with related goals: Ensure a Strong Start for Kids. Increase the number of children ready for kindergarten from 44 to 90 percent Ensure Early Grade Excellence: Increase the number of children reading at grade level by the end of third grade from 75 to 90 percent. Betye Martin Baker Human Service Center - The Center proivdes office space for seven nonprolifits, offering services such as volunteer opportunities, job referrals, education, counseling, child care, and employment training. By making reduced rent available, we aid these nonprofits in furthering their mission. \$414,893 South Sound 2-1-1 - This free and confidential service connects people with critical resources that save and help improve lives in Pierce, Thurston and Lewis counties, 2-1-1 received 37,551 calls and connected an additional 41,429 online for a total of 79,980 contacts, compared to 44,103 calls and 35,246 web connections (total 79,349) in 2014. The top ten requested needs were utility assistance, rent, mortgage and move-in assistance, low cost housing, health and dental issues, food, transportation, emergency shelter, legal, clothing and personal goods and transitional housing. Our 2-1-1 web page continues to be one of the most visited pages of the United Way website. \$304,771. Retired Senior Volunteer Program (RSVP) - We were awarded sponsorship of this program in 2007. RSVP engages individuals ages 55 and over in meaningful serivce to the community. In 2015, RSVP engaged 406 volunteers in 86,340 hours of service at 24 nonprofit sites; 2014 421 volunteers in 89,553 hours of service at 28 sites. \$130,730. General volunteerism: Made 2,695 connections to volunteer opportunities with 237 different nonprofits through our website; Conneted 80 volunteers to opportunities by phone or in person; Our website had 3,423 unique visitors, 8,590 site visits and 16,239 page vies focused on volunteerism; 38 group projects coordinated engaging 420 volunteers in 1,152 hours of service.
