Robert H.Y. Leong devoted approximately 13 hours per week to operate and administer the Foundation during 2015. Robert H.Y. Leong & Company, as the common paymaster, reported his wages, contributions to employee benefit plans and related expenses. Other officers and directors devoted less than 1% of their time to the operation of the Foundation.
