Houston Marathon Foundation ("HMF") submits that throughout its existence to date and in the future, it qualifies as a public charity under Internal Revenue Code \$509(a)(1) by satisfying the requirements of Regulations \$1.170A-9(f)(3) as follows:

- (i). Ten Percent Test: HMF has historically and normally can be expected in the future to receive over 10% of its total support from the general public. The organization was formed in 2006 and has been significantly supported by Houston Marathon Committee during its start up period. Now that HMF's public fundraising campaign is maturing, it expects its public support percentage to exceed 33 1/3% in the near future.
- (ii). Attraction of Public Support: Because HMF is dedicated to providing support to running related programs and initiatives in the Greater Houston area, it has to date attracted gifts from approximately 750 donors. since inception, HMF has received a significant amount of its support from two major contributors but expects to increase the number of small donations it received annually to reach the 33 1/3% requirement.
- (iii).Percentage of Financial Support: HMF received about 30% of its total support from public sources for the five year period ending 4/30/16 and reasonably expects for that ratio to rise to above 33 1/3% in the year.
- (iv). Sources of Support: HMF receives its support from a representative number of foundations and individuals, rather than receiving almost all of its support from the members of a single family or small group of individuals. HMF has to date received gifts from approximately 750 contributors.

(v). Availability of Facilities or Services and Public Participation: HMF's programs impact thousand of runners in the Greater Houston area. As described in Part III, over 5,000 individuals participated in the organization's annual Fun Run which is a joint program conducted with Texas Children's Hospital.

CONCLUSION: HMF believes it qualifies as a publicly supported charity described in IRC §509(a)(1) pursuant to the facts and circumstances test found in Treasury Regulation §1.170A-9(f)(3). HMF has and will receive well in excess of ten percent (10%) of its total support from qualifying public sources, has an active fundraising program, and possesses a majority of the characteristics that describe organizations that meet this test.
