Premises

The Transferor Foundation represents and warrants that it is a Kansas charitable trust, an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and a private foundation within the meaning of Section 509(a) of the Code.
- 2. <u>Transferee Foundation Representations</u>. The Transferee Foundation represents and warrants that it is a Kansas charitable trust, an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, and a private foundation within the meaning of Section 509(a) of the Code.
- 3. <u>Transferor Foundation Contributions</u>. The Transferor Foundation shall promptly contribute all of its assets, consisting of cash and investments, to the Transferee Foundation.
- 4. <u>Transferee Foundation Assumption</u>. The Transferee Foundation hereby assumes and agrees to pay and discharge when due all of the Transferor Foundation's charitable commitments and administrative expenses.

5. Miscellaneous.

(a) This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement of the parties with respect to the subject matter of this Agreement. This Agreement shall be binding upon and shall inure to the benefit of the parties hereto and their successors and assigns. This Agreement may be amended or modified only by an agreement in writing signed by each party to this Agreement.

- (b) This Agreement is for the sole benefit of the parties hereto and their respective successors and assigns and nothing herein is intended or shall confer on any other person any right of any nature whatsoever.
 - (c) This Agreement shall be governed by Kansas law.
