Altogether, over 22.5 million tracts and calendar cards, as well as over 48,000 other evangelistic materials, were distributed both domestically and internationally by way of sales and free distribution. The free distribution of tracts were given to a variety of churches, individuals, and ministries primarily within the United States.
