## AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION OF THE FOUNDATION FOR HEALTH, INC.

Pursuant to the provisions of KRS 273.267 and 273.273, the undersigned corporation hereby executes these Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation (the "Articles").

FIRST: The name of the corporation is The Foundation For Health, Inc.

SECOND: The Articles of Incorporation of the corporation are amended and restated to read in their entirety as follows:

#### ARTICLE I

#### NAME

The name of the corporation is Owensboro Health Foundation, Inc. (the "Corporation").

#### ARTICLE II

#### **PURPOSES AND POWERS**

The purposes for which the Corporation is formed, the business and objects to be carried on and promoted by it, and the powers granted to it, are as follows:

- A. The particular purposes of the Corporation are as follows:
- 1. To serve as a fundraising organization in support of the charitable mission and activities of Owensboro Health, Inc. or its successor organization ("OHI"), so long as OHI qualifies as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the "Code"), and otherwise to conduct activities in support of, make contributions to or for the benefit of, and promote the charitable interests of, OHI.

- 2. In furtherance of the foregoing, the Corporation may also, at the direction of and subject to any limitations imposed by OHI, conduct activities in support of, and make contributions to, and promote the charitable interests of, any other organization that is directly or indirectly controlled by OHI, including Owensboro Health Medical Group, Inc. or its successor organization, that then qualifies as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, which may include any limited liability company treated as a "disregarded entity" (pursuant to Section 7701 of the Code) that is wholly owned by any such Section 501(c)(3) organization or by OHI and that itself conducts charitable activities (each such Section 501(c)(3) organization or disregarded entity is an "Affiliated Charity").
- To solicit, collect, receive, accumulate, invest, administer and disburse funds in furtherance of the Corporation's charitable mission.
- 4. To carry out such other activities as are consistent with Article II.A.1, above, to the extent not otherwise prohibited by these Articles.
- B. The Corporation is irrevocably dedicated to and is organized and shall be operated exclusively for charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. In carrying out its corporate purposes, the Corporation shall have all of the powers allowed corporations by the Kentucky Nonprofit Corporation Acts (KRS 273.161, et seq.) or its successor provisions; provided, however, that the Corporation shall not have or exercise any power prohibited by the provisions of these Articles.

- C. As limited by Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, it is expressly not the purpose of the Corporation, and the Corporation is not empowered, to participate or intervene in (including the publication or distributing of statements) any political campaign activity on behalf of or in opposition to any candidate for public office, nor to devote more than an insubstantial part of its activities to carrying on propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation.
- D. Any other provision of these Articles to the contrary notwithstanding, the Corporation shall have no capital stock and no power to issue certificates of stock or to declare dividends; no part of the net earnings of the Corporation shall inure to the benefit of any private shareholder or individual; and the Corporation shall not carry on any activities denied to an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code, including activities prohibited by Section 501(m) of the Code.
- E. Any other provision of these Articles to the contrary notwithstanding, the Corporation shall, if the following provisions of law are applicable to it: [i] not engage in any act of self-dealing as defined in Section 4941 of the Code; [ii] distribute its income for each fiscal year at such time and in such manner as not to be subject to the tax under Section 4942 of the Code; [iii] not retain any excess business holdings as defined in Section 4943 of the Code; [iv] not make any investments in such manner as to subject the Corporation to tax under Section 4944 of the Code; and [v] not make any taxable expenditures as defined in Section 4945 of the Code.

#### ARTICLE III

#### **DURATION**

The Corporation shall have perpetual existence.

#### **ARTICLE IV**

#### **MEMBERSHIP**

Owensboro Health, Inc. shall be the sole member of the Corporation. The sole member shall not be required to pay membership fees or dues and shall not be liable for the debts or liabilities of the Corporation by virtue of being the sole member thereof. The Corporation shall not have any other members, nor confer membership status or rights upon any person or entity other than the sole member.

#### **ARTICLE V**

#### **DIRECTORS**

The affairs of the Corporation shall be managed under the direction of a Board of Directors consisting of not less than five (5) directors and not more than twenty-five (25) directors, with the exact number to be established in such manner as is provided in the Corporation's bylaws (the "Bylaws"). The term of office, election process and the qualifications or criteria for office shall be as provided in the Bylaws. Notwithstanding the foregoing or anything contrary in the Bylaws, the sole member may remove any director at any time, with or without cause.

#### ARTICLE VI

#### **OFFICERS**

The Bylaws shall identify the Corporation's officers and describe their duties.

#### ARTICLE VII

#### **AMENDMENT OF ARTICLES OR BYLAWS**

Any amendment of these Articles or of the Bylaws (or adoption or repeal of the Bylaws) must be approved by the Board of Directors and by the sole member.

#### ARTICLE VIII

### CONTRACTS OR TRANSACTION OF BUSINESS WITH DIRECTORS

Any contract or transaction of business between the Corporation and one or more of its directors, or with any corporation or other legal entity of which any of its directors is a stockholder, director, trustee or officer, shall not be invalidated or affected solely by the fact that such director or directors have or may have interests therein which are or might be adverse to the interests of the Corporation; provided, however, that a director who holds such a position or who has or may have such an interest adverse to that of the Corporation shall disclose such interest to the Board of Directors, and shall not vote on any such contract or transaction, although he or she may be counted in determining the existence of a quorum. In addition to the foregoing, the Corporation shall have and maintain a conflict of interest policy applicable to its officers and directors. Notwithstanding the foregoing, provided that there is no direct or indirect financial benefit to any director or officer, contracts or transactions that are exclusively between the Corporation and OHI and/or an Affiliated Charity, and grant applications received from and contributions made to OHI or an Affiliated Charity, shall not constitute a conflict of interest for purposes of this Article VIII. The Corporation shall be prohibited from making loans to any of its directors or officers.

#### ARTICLE IX

#### **INDEMNIFICATION**

Each person who is or was a director, committee member or officer of the Corporation, whether elected or appointed, and each person who is or was serving at the request of the Corporation as a director, trustee, committee member or officer of another corporation, whether elected or appointed, including the heirs, executors, administrators or estate of any such person, shall be indemnified by the Corporation to the full amount against any liability, and the reasonable cost, or expense (including attorneys' fees, monetary or other judgments, fines, excise taxes or penalties and amounts paid or to be paid in settlement) incurred by such person in such person's capacity as a director, trustee, committee member or officer or arising out of such person's status as a director, trustee, committee member or officer; provided, however, that no such person shall be indemnified against any such liability, cost or expense incurred in connection with any action, suit or proceeding in which such person shall have been adjudged liable on the basis that personal benefit was improperly received by such person, or if such indemnification would be prohibited by law, including any payment that could jeopardize the Corporation's Section 501(c)(3) status or would result in any excise tax under Section 4958 of the Code. Such right of indemnification shall be a contract right and shall include the right to be paid by the Corporation the reasonable expenses incurred in defending any threatened or pending action, suit or proceeding in advance of its final disposition; provided, however, that such advance payment of expenses shall be made only after delivery to the Corporation of an undertaking by or on behalf of such person to repay all amounts so advanced if it shall be determined that such person is not entitled to such indemnification. Any repeal or modification of this Article IX shall not affect any rights or obligation then existing. If any

indemnification payment required by this Article IX is not paid by the Corporation within ninety (90) days after a written claim has been received by the Corporation, the director, trustee, committee member or officer may, at any time thereafter, bring suit against the Corporation to recover the unpaid amount and, if successful in whole or in substantial part, such person shall be entitled to be paid also the reasonable expense of prosecuting such claim. The Corporation may maintain insurance, at its own expense, to protect itself and any such persons against any such liability, cost or expense, whether or not the Corporation would have the power to indemnify such person against such liability, cost or expense under the Kentucky Nonprofit Corporation Acts or under this Article IX, but it shall not be obligated to do so. The indemnification provided by this Article IX shall not be deemed exclusive of any other rights which those seeking indemnification may have or hereafter acquire under any Bylaw, agreement, statute, vote of Board of Directors or otherwise. If this Article IX or any portion thereof shall be invalidated on any ground by any court of competent jurisdiction, then the Corporation nevertheless shall indemnify each such person, to the full extent permitted by any applicable portion of this Article IX that shall not have been invalidated or that remains enforceable under any other applicable law.

#### ARTICLE X

#### DISSOLUTION

Dissolution shall be accomplished in accordance with Chapter 273 of the Kentucky Revised Statutes or its successor. Upon dissolution of the Corporation, the Board of Directors shall, after paying or making provision for the payment of all liabilities of the Corporation, dispose of all remaining assets by distributing such assets to OHI so long as OHI then qualifies as an organization described in Section 501(c)(3) of the Code. If OHI does not then so qualify, the Board of Directors

modification of this Article XI shall not adversely affect any right or protection of a director of the Corporation existing at the time of such repeal or modification.

THIRD: The foregoing amendment and restatement was adopted by the affirmative vote of not less than a majority of the members of the Board of Directors of the Corporation on September 3, 2015, pursuant to KRS 273.263 and 273.273, and by the Corporation's sole member on September 28, 2015.

FOURTH: These Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation shall be effective as of the date and time of filing with the Secretary of State of the Commonwealth of Kentucky.

FIFTH: Article III has been restated. Articles I, II, IV, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI and XII have been amended to read in their entirety as set forth herein.

SIXTH: The foregoing Amended and Restated Articles of Incorporation were duly adopted as required by law, correctly set forth without change the corresponding provisions of the Articles of Incorporation as heretofore and herein amended, and supersede the original Articles of Incorporation and all amendments thereto.
