Assistance League Scholarships awards college scholarships to seniors graduating from Santa Ana Unified School District's Career Technical Education Program (CTE). Students must have teacher recommendations, the desire to attend either a 4-year college or a community college, and a financial need. Scholarships are paid after verification of enrollment on a semester or quarter basis. Unique to the scholarship program is that each student also receives one-on-one mentoring from an Assistance League member volunteer while attending college. Many recipients are the first in their family to attend college. Each year between 20-25 scholarships are awarded and presented at a spring reception at the Assistance League facility for the recipients' families, teachers, principals, and SAUSD guests.

Other Programs primarily include Serving Eager Eyes (SEE) which provides an eye examination and eye glasses for qualifying students of the Santa Ana Unified School District. Students are identified and referred by the school nurse as being in need of this service. This past year, 59 students were served through this program.
