Excavations:

The School maintains two active excavations at the Athenian Agora and at the Cornith site which are year round sites. During the summer approximately 40 students take part in a 8 week excavation season at the Agora. Both excavations maintain archaeological collections which are overseen by the Greek Archaeological Service.

Publications and Libraries:

The American School maintains and operates two research libraies holding about 236,000 volumes. The Blegen Library has one of the most complete collections in the world for research in the civilization of ancient Greece. The Gennaduis Library houses both volumes and electronic resources which comprise the most significant collection for the study of Hellenic civilization after the end of antiquity.

The School publishes scholarly reserarch in the form of books (3-5 volumes per year) in addition to a quarterly Journal. The current catalogue of available publications is about 200 titles.
