CTC continues the development, demonstration, test, and refinement of the AMIT application in support of anticipatory intelligence and works with the Government to identify and integrate new commercial and GOTS analytics into the AI2 infrastructure, developing the AMIT APIs and framework as required

Schedule R, Part V Line 1a	Under an existing Financing and Security Agreement, with a syndicate of financial institutions, CTC and its controlled affiliates are all named parties under this Agreement, with their respective, individual assets pledged as collateral. Part of the streamlined business process created by this Agreement requires CTC to serve as the primary cash custodian, initiating all cash borrowings, and repayments, on behalf of itself and its affiliates. Cash proceeds are then passed on to its affiliates as operating capital requests are made. Interest charges assessed to CTC by its lender are passed through to its affiliates, on a pro rata basis, with corresponding affiliate interest reimbursements made to CTC.
Schedule R, Part V Line 1d	Under an existing Financing and Security Agreement, with a syndicate of financial institutions, CTC and its controlled affiliates are all named parties under this Agreement, with their respective, individual assets pledged as collateral. Part of the streamlined business process created by this Agreement requires CTC to serve as the primary cash custodian, initiating all cash borrowings and repayments, on behalf of itself and its affiliates. By virtue of this Agreement, and despite the cross-collateralized nature of the assets, CTC and each of its affiliates are individually responsible for their respective share of borrowings from the lender. CTC accounts for each affiliate's share accordingly.
Schedule R, Part V Line 1j	Given the proximity of CTC Enterprise Ventures Corporation (EVC) to CTC, EVC occupies space within CTC's facilities. EVC is responsible for its proportionate share of the cost of the space, including maintenance, utilities and equipment usage, if any. CTC imposes a monthly facilities fee to cover these expenses. Annual usage and expense examinations are made to determine the appropriateness of this monthly fee and any required fee adjustments are made in accordance with its findings.
Schedule R, Part V Line 1l	In an effort to eliminate the duplication of staff and reduce the infrastructure required of its controlled affiliates, CTC performs certain general and administrative functions on behalf of each affiliate. These tasks may include accounts receivable and contract billing, accounts payable and purchasing, payroll and employee benefits and other general administrative functions. Transactions are properly recorded in the books of the respective affiliates and CTC assesses each affiliate a prorated support charge to cover its actual costs of performing these services.
Schedule R, Part V Line 1q	During the normal course of performing the general and administrative function of each affiliate, CTC may incur costs, other than administrative costs, specific to an affiliate that must be reimbursed by that affiliate. These costs are properly recorded in the books of the respective affiliates, with corresponding reimbursement of these expenses to CTC. All reimbursements are made at actual cost with no administrative fee paid to CTC.
Schedule R, Part V Line 1r	During the normal course of business CTC may transfer property and/or equipment to affiliates based on need. The fair market value of such property/equipment is properly recorded in the books of the respective affiliate, with corresponding reimbursement to CTC.
