The stakeholders are members of the Central Public Health District Coordinating Council, as well as a list of participants who participated in the 2010-11 Community Health Assessment forums held collaboratively with the Central Public Health District, MGMC and EMH. Twenty-one stakeholders completed the survey. 33 percent represented nonprofit community organizations, seven percent represented healthcare (non-physician), 26 percent represented public health, 13 percent represented schools.
