

The most likely situation for an individual is a perceived conflict of interest which results in that individual disclosing this situation during the normal course of business, and subsequently recusing themselves from a vote or decision of the organization. The organization and its staff has a history of active monitoring of such situations. In the case of the board of directors and its committees, the minutes from meetings and voting records identify when a member recuses themselves due to perceived conflicts of interest in the case of staff, it is common for an employee to contact their supervisor and the managing partner, operations when a question arises. The issue is discussed and in most cases the managing partner, operations provides the employee with an interpretation and instructions on how to proceed based upon the description of the situation. These activities take place via conversations as well as digitally at times using e-mail if a situation is complex or unclear, it is elevated to the finance/audit committee for a decision with e-mail being the usual vehicle to do so. The organization also conducts annual training on compliance with our conflict of interest polices and educa
