determined that transfers between board designated, unrestricted net assets and undesignated, unrestricted net assets had been incorrectly
recorded. As these transfers were immaterial for audit purposes, the audited financial statements were not changed. The corrected transfers
were posted to the books, and are reflected in the amounts in col. a for the current year. These corrections result in the expenditures being a
positive amount, rather than the usual, negative amount for the current year.
Part V, Line 4: The Educational Foundation's endowments are used to make learning accessible to students in need and to enhance the
programs and services of Oakton Community College District 535. Specifically, the endowments provide (a) scholarship awards enabling

fall outside the College's annual operating budget.
Part X, Line 1: The opening balance for this fiscal year included an outstanding liability of \$8,870 for an Annuity Payable. This was completely
written off as of the end of the fiscal year, June 30, 2016.
Part X, Line 2: As stated in Footnote 2.h. (p. 9) of the audited financial statements, "The Foundation is a tax-exempt, not-for-profit organization
under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code per the Internal Revenue Service determination letter dated October 1977. The
Foundation has evaluated its tax positions for all open tax years. Currently, the tax years open and subject to examination by the Internal
Revenue Service are the 2013, 2014, and 2015 tax years. However, the Foundation is not currently under audit nor has the Foundation been
contacted by any jurisdiction. Based on the evaluation of the Foundation's tax positions, management believes all tax positions taken would
be upheld under an examination. Therefore, no provision for the effects of uncertain tax positions has been recorded for FYE June 30, 2016."
Part XI, Line 2d: The \$18,311 fundraising expense "Cost of direct benefit" to donors was netted in the 990, Part VIII, Statement of Revenue, but
was included in the gross revenues of the audited financial statements, p. 5.
