

The BOT delegates certain activities and responsibilities to Boards of each of Sanford's primary operating subsidiaries. The unique nature and complexity of the subsidiaries requires each to have a delegated Board with a singular entity focus. Such bodies, referred to as Boards of Directors and Boards of Governors, address matters such as credentialing, accreditation standards, developing budgets, programs and facilities on an entity-specific basis, and generally consist of individuals distinct from the BOT. These Boards function much like committees in a traditional corporate structure. The BOT then act as a holding company Board, synthesizing and reconciling each entity's programs and budgets into a system-wide strategic plan. This structure of governance produces a significant number of trustees, governors and directors. Sanford is the sole member of Sanford Health. Sanford Health is the sole member of the organization. The Board of Trustees delegates authority to the Board of Directors of the
