

The President's salary is set by the College's Compensation Committee. The committee is led by the Board Chair and includes several other Board members who have been appointed to the committee by the Board Chair. The purpose of the committee is to review the President's job performance and determine the appropriate salary to recommend to the full Board of Trustees. The Trustees meet in Executive session during the annual May meeting to receive the report of the Compensation Committee and act on their recommendation. The actions of the Board of Trustees while in Executive session are documented in the minutes of the meeting. In October 2010, the College obtained the service of an independent consultant to analyze the President's compensation package with Presidential compensation data from approximately ten (10) to fifteen (15) comparator colleges. In fiscal year 2015-16, a new study was performed by an independent consultant to review the compensation of senior management and the President and recommend to the Compensation Committee where any adjustments were necessary.
