- WSOL publishes a monthly Newsletter containing information on upcoming WSO concerts and events. WMA President and WSO Music Director regularly contribute articles to this Newsletter. This is the only Newsletter published for WMA.

NO OTHER ORGANIZATIONS OR INDIVIDUALS PROVIDE THESE VOLUNTEER SUPPORT FUNCTIONS FOR WSO. TOTAL VOLUNTEER HOURS FOR THESE ENDEAVORS EXCEED 3,000 HOURS ANNUALLY.

#### **PROVIDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE:**

WSOL annually hosts the following fundraising events in sole support of WMA, d/b/a the WSO:-

- Annual "Encore Affairs". Eight events were held in this tax reporting year.
- Conversation with the Conductor Luncheon.
- Wine tasting dinner/recital.
- Pink Elephant fundraiser.
- Annual "Own Your Own Orchestra " campaign.

Annual Fundraising Projects and Goals are presented to WSO Resource and Development Committee for review and coordination. No other organization supports WSO with fundraising events as outlined. The \$42,550 in monetary support to WMA would not be possible without this fundraising assistance.
