EXHIBIT "A"

AMENDED AND RESTATED ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF

JEFFERSON REGIONAL FOUNDATION

- 1. The name of the corporation is Jefferson Regional Foundation.
- The address of the corporation's registered office in this Commonwealth is 565 Coal Valley Road, Jefferson Hills, Allegheny County, Pennsylvania 15025.
- 3. The corporation is organized under the Nonprofit Corporation Law of 1988 exclusively for the purposes set forth in Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or the corresponding provision of any future United States Internal Revenue Law) (the "Code") and, in furtherance thereof, to support Jefferson Regional Medical Center, a Pennsylvania nonprofit corporation, provided that such corporation is an organization described in Section 509(a)(1) or (2) of the Code. The corporation shall operate exclusively for charitable, educational, and scientific purposes, causes and objects now or at any time hereafter fostered by the supported organization.
- 4 The corporation does not contemplate pecuniary gain or profit, incidental or otherwise
- 5. The corporation is organized on a nonstock basis.
- 6. The power to alter, amend, or repeal these Articles of Incorporation or the Bylaws of the corporation shall be determined as provided in the Bylaws.
- 7. No part of the net earnings of the corporation shall inure to the benefit of or be distributable to any of its officers, directors, or other private persons, except that the corporation shall be authorized and empowered to pay reasonable compensation for services rendered and to make payments and distributions in furtherance of its purposes as set forth in these Articles of Incorporation.
- 8. No substantial part of the activities of the corporation shall be the carrying on of propaganda or otherwise attempting to influence legislation, and the corporation shall not participate in or intervene in (including the publishing or distribution of statements) any political campaign on behalf of any or in opposition to any candidate for public office.
- Notwithstanding any provisions of these Articles of Incorporation, the corporation shall not carry on any activity not permitted to be carried on by a corporation organized and operated exclusively for exempt purposes and or by a corporation, contributions to which are deductible under Section 170(c)(2) of the Code.
- 10. In the event of the dissolution of the corporation or in the winding up of its affairs, or other liquidation of its assets, the corporation's property shall not be conveyed to any organization created or operated for profit or to any individual for less than the fair market value of such property. All assets remaining after all debts and expenses of the corporation have been paid or provided for shall be conveyed or distributed by the Board of Directors to one or more organizations qualifying for the exemption afforded by Section 501(c)(3) of the Code and, if possible and practical, to Jefferson Regional Medical Center or an organization or organizations created and operated for nonprofit purposes similar to those of this corporation as the Board of Directors of this corporation may determine. Any such assets not so distributed shall be disposed of pursuant to an order by a court of competent jurisdiction, exclusively for such purposes or to such organization or organizations, as said court shall determine.
