In taxable year ending June 30, 2016, The Mary Peace Sterling Foundation (the "Foundation") discovered that on its Form 990-PF for taxable year ending June 30, 2015, Parts X and XI were not recorded properly. The Foundation would not have been subject to an underdistribution penalty under §4942 for the year ending June 30, 2015 if the average value of the assets had been properly recorded in Part X. Therefore, the Foundation has chosen not to amend Form 990-PF for taxable year ending June 30, 2015. Instead, the Foundation has adjusted the amount reported in Part XIII of Form 990-PF for year ending June 30, 2016 to reflect the correct balance.
