Georgia Elks Aidmore Auxiliary is a Functionally-Integrated Supporting Organization of the Georgia Elks Association. A requirement of membership is that you must be the spouse or widow of and Elk Member in good standing. Both organizations meet three (3) times a year, separately and jointly, to conduct business, elect, install officers and appoint committees. Elks Aidmore, Inc. is the major project for both organizations. The Georgia Elks Aidmore Auxiliary collects membership dues each spring to budget for the operation of the organization. Funds are raised to support Elks Aidmore, Inc. through fund raising projects and donations from local Auxiliaries. The funds are given to Elks Aidmore, Inc. at the spring meeting and any funds left from the budget are presented in the fall, after the annual audit.

Elks Aidmore, Inc. has a residential program in Conyers, GA for young women (12-21) who have been removed from their homes, to provide safe housing, education, training, therapy and life skills. There is also a transitional living program for older youth, community based alternatives for youth and foster care. There are two foster care offices that opened this past year in Savannah and Valdosta, GA.

Georgia Elks Aidmore Auxiliary has four positions on the Board of Trustees, three postions on the Executive committee and numerous volunteers on campus for various activities. Every function of the Auxiliary is documented in a Handbook, updated annually, for Elks and Auxiliary members identifying support for Elks Aidmore, Inc.
