Intervention plans aimed at targeting these individuals are also developed to combat some of the socio-economic factors which have historically had a negative impact on residents' health - to increase accessibility to preventative services for all community residents, more accessible preventive services will prove beneficial in accomplishing the first goal (improving health status, increasing life spans, and elevating quality of life), as well as lowering the costs associated with caring for late-stage diseases resul


