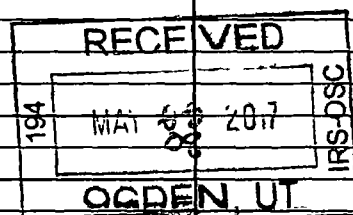

HOW DISTRIBUTION ACCOMPLISHES CHARITABLE PURPOSE:

SINCE ITS INCEPTION, IT HAS WORKED TO TRANSFORM GENEROSITY INTO IMPACT TO REALIZE A STRONGER, HEALTHIER, AND MORE PROSPEROUS FUTURE FOR THOSE NOT ONLY LIVING IN LOS ANGELES BUT ACROSS THE COUNTRY AND AROUND THE WORLD.
