The instructions indicate that we should have filed for an extension of time to time to file the form 990 by submitting a form 8868, Application of Extension of Time to File and Exempt Organization Return. An extension was not filed for the above referenced entity for the year ended June 30, 2016 The instructions to the form 990 indicates that under IRC section 6652(c)(1)(A) a penalty can be charged when a return is filed late, unless the organization can show that the late filing was due to reasonable cause. We believe that reasonable cause exists for the late filing of the enclosed form 990. We therefore request no penalty relating to the late filing of the enclosed form 990 be charged against the organization Facts The person responsible for preparing the form 990 is the Assistant Treasurer of the organization I, Patricia A Matsumoto, was hired as the Assistant Treasurer in July 2015 The former Assistant Treasurer continued to be employed for a period of time after I was hired in his place. The former Assistant Treasurer had been in his position for more than 30 years. The extension of time to file the form 990 for the previous fiscal year (ending June 30, 2015) was prepared and filed by the former Assistant Treasurer At a meeting of executives in February 2016, the Treasurer mentioned the requirement to complete the form 990 before the deadline of February 15, 2016. After reading the instructions to the form 8868, I understood that the filing of the form could be further extended to May 15, 2016. Although records were not well kept, my staff and I were able to make sense of the transactions and compiled information necessary to prepare the form 990 with complete and accurate data and other information. We filed the form 990 for the period ending June 30, 2015 (the previous year) by May 15, 2016 My predecessor did not keep a calendar of events that included the filing deadline for the form 990 for the organization by November 15, 2016. As a result, the initial filing deadline was overlooked by our office. During February of this year (2017) I became aware of the prior year February 2016 discussion regarding the filing deadline for the form 990. I then realized that initial extension of time for filing form for the enclosed form 990 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2016 was not filed. I made it a priority to have my staff compile the information necessary to prepare a form 990 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2016 in a complete and accurate manner. I believe that the information contained on the enclosed form 990 is complete and accurate for the period indicated. I have made sure that the Treasurer, myself (Assistant Treasurer), and the Administrator have put on a recurring calendar the due date (November 15) for the filing of the annual form 990 for the organization. I have further implemented accounting procedures to make use of accounting software to account for transactions for the organization. Formerly, the data was maintained manually with little structure which made it difficult to compile the information required to prepare a complete and accurate form 990 Reasonable cause exception. We believe that reasonable cause exists because of 1) There was no intentional disregard of the rules for timely filing the form 990 2) The Treasurers' office was not aware of the filing deadline. Instead, the organization had relied on the form Assistant Treasurer (who had been in his position for 30 years ending in 2015) 3) Immediately upon realizing the oversight of filing the initial extension, this office made every attempt to compile the information in a manner to prepare the enclosed form 990 in a complete and accurate manner 4) We have put in place procedures to ensure that the time for filing the return or the time for filing the extension in the future will never again be missed 5) We have updated our procedures to not only ensure that due dates are not missed but also improved our accounting for transactions that should be reported on the form 990 Conclusion. Based on the above, we believe that reasonable cause does exist for the late filing of the enclosed form 990 for the above referenced organization and fiscal year. There was never an intentional disregard of the rules for the timely filing of the enclosed form 990. We have put in place policies and procedures to ensure that the deadline is not missed in future years. We therefore request that you do not assess penalties for the late filing of the enclosed return.
