## **FOUNDATION PROCEDURES**

The late Mr. John Henry Rodgers established The Lincoln Foundation and The Lane Foundation to enable deserving young men and women in the Norfolk community to obtain a quality education.

Organized and incorporated under the laws of the State of Virginia in 1928, The Lincoln Foundation, The Lane Foundation, and their successor, The Lincoln-Lane Foundation award scholarship grants to Tidewater, Virginia residents. The purpose of the grants is to allow recipients to pursue full-time study at accredited post-secondary four-year schools, colleges and universities located in the United States.

Scholarship applicants are selected annually on the basis of scholastic achievements as evidenced by academic records, tests and extra-curricular activities, and demonstrated financial need. High potential for achievement in community service is also a consideration. Application forms are available annually beginning September 1<sup>st</sup> upon written request from the individual student. Letters requesting applications must be postmarked no later than the 15<sup>th</sup> of October. The application and all required documents should be promptly forwarded to the Foundation. Applicants will be notified of the Foundation's decision in regards to their application by the middle of April. Awards are contingent upon continued demonstrated financial need, satisfactory academic performance, and may be altered by the Foundation at its own discretion.

The Foundation does not provide funds for endowment or building programs. It does not provide funds for general support or annual fund-raising campaigns. Under the Federal Tax Reform Act of 1969 and 1976, The Lincoln-Lane Foundation is classified as a private educational foundation within the meaning of Section 501 (C) (3) of the U. S. Internal Revenue Code. All available funds must be used each year for the purpose of awarding scholarship grants to those students who qualify. THE FOUNDATION IS UNABLE TO MAKE LOANS OF ANY KIND.

Grants recipients are required to submit periodic official transcripts or progress reports to the Foundation. The Foundation, in turn, must maintain accurate and thorough financial records since it is required by law to exercise expenditure responsibility for all grants made to individuals. Detailed reports, with respect to such scholarship grants, are made annually to The Internal Revenue Service. The Foundation's financial records, including Tax Returns and Annual Reports are made available for public inspection each year.
