These organizations benefit from all services of the officer and key employee functions, and this structure allows for major cost savings as a result of not hiring or filling officer or key employee positions in each of the subsidiary entities. A significant portion of the compensation is supported financially by the six (6) entities and reimbursed to Easter Seals New Hampshire for their proportionate share The amounts reported in Part VII, Column (D) and Schedule J, Part II, row (I) reflect the compensation received with respect to services performed for the reporting entity only. 
