Porter provides a number of community health outreach programs to the general public for free or at minimal charge. The programs include but are not limited to diabetes education, breast cancer screening, prenatal classes, breastfeeding classes, and CPR coerces. Porter provides clinical office space to the Open Door Clinic. Finally, Porter has partnered with local career center, as well as colleges to provided clinical exposure to their students with goals of developing future healthcare workers for the community
