

This program provides undergraduate students an intensive research and academic experience in a human sleep and chronobiology research laboratory, helps support summer teaching assistantships, and provides opportunities for young scientists to serve as visiting scholars/role models at the retreat. The Foundation also transferred \$45,000 to EPBH to support outpatient psychiatric services at the New port Child and Adolescent Behavioral Health Clinic, a partnership between EPBH and New port Hospital in New port, Rhode Island. This clinic has been able to help fill the void that existed for New port County families with limited resources available to help children in emotional distress or psychological crisis. Additionally, \$39,513 was transferred to EPBH to support the operations of the Intensive Program for Obsessive-Compulsive Disorder (OCD), including the purchase of equipment.
