AND CONTINUING LONGITUDINAL FOLLOW-UP STUDIES HAVE CONFIRMED THE PROGRAM'S EFFECTIVENESS. THESE TRIAL OUTCOMES DEMONSTRATE THAT NURSE-FAMILY PARTNERSHIP DELIVERS AGAINST ITS THREE PRIMARY GOALS - MAKING MEASURABLE IMPACT ON THE LIVES OF CHILDREN, FAMILIES AND THE COMMUNITIES IN WHICH THEY LIVE.
