The Foundation made a \$13,000 irrevocable distribution to a donor advised fund sponsored by the Central Florida Foundation, Inc. ("the Sponsoring Organization") for the purpose of providing small "micro-grants" (in amounts not to exceed \$1,000 per grantee) to nonprofit organizations that support and assist children and youth in Orange County, Florida and the surrounding communities, consistent with the exempt purposes of both the Foundation and the Sponsoring Organization. The Foundation solicits, processes, and vets grant applications that meet these criteria. All funds held in the donor advised fund are normally distributed to selected grantees within one year of the Foundation's distribution to the donor advised fund. The Foundation made a \$38,000 irrevocable distribution to a second donor advised fund sponsored by the Sponsoring Organization for the purpose of providing capital to maintain the facility used by Orlando Day Nursery as recommended by the Kiwanis Club of Orlando Foundation Board. The Foundation made a \$32,000 irrevocable distribution to a third donor advised fund sponsored by the Sponsoring Organization for the purpose of providing capital to maintain the facility used by Orlando Day Nursery or other 501(c)(3) entity as recommended by the Kiwanis Club of Orlando Foundation Board. The Foundation made a \$100,000 irrevocable distribution to a fourth donor advised fund sponsored by the Sponsoring Organization to help disadvantaged youth in Orlando, Orange County and surrounding communities. The Sponsoring Organization completes due diligence on all grant recommendations. The Foundation's Board of Directors serves as an Advisory Committee to advise the Sponsoring Organization of its wishes concerning distributions from the donor advised funds, but understands that the Sponsoring Organization will evaluate whether the advice is consistent with the specific needs of the proposed recipient and deserving of the support according to the criteria of the Sponsoring Organization. Pursuant to the donor advised fund agreements, the Sponsoring Organization is not legally bound by the advice of the Foundation's Advisory Committee.
