ONIC's income tax returns are subject to review and examination by federal authorities. ONIC is not aware of any activities that would jeopardize its tax-exempt status. ONIC is not aware of any activities that are subject to tax on unrelated business income, excise or other taxes. The tax returns for the fiscal years ended from 2013 to 2015 are open to examination by federal authorities.


