records to identify and monitor the level of charity care it provides. These records include the amount of charges foregone for services and supplies furnished under its chanty care policy. Charges foregone, based on established rates, totaled approximately \$66,718,839 in fiscal year 2016. Based on the gross charges provided to chanty patients compared to total hospital gross charges, 2 8% of all services in fiscal year 2016 were provided on a chanty basis. The net cost of chanty care provided by NMMC was approximately \$18,411,467 in fiscal year 2016. The total cost estimate is based on the ratio of costs to charges for NMMC.
