DURING THE YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 2016, MCHSH DID NOT OPERATE A HOSPITAL FACILITY THAT IS REQUIRED TO BE LICENSED, REGISTEPED OR SIMILARLY RECOGNIZED BY A STATE AS A HOSPITAL. SINCE MCHSH WAS NOT LICENSED BY THE STATE, NOR WAS OPERATING ANY HOSPITALS, THE ORGANIZATION IS NOT COMPLETING A SCHEDULE H FOR THE YEAR ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 2016.
