

In addition, the Compensation committee, a sub-group of the Board of Directors, regularly utilizes several for-profit and non-profit salary surveys to establish and validate the CEO's salary. Once the data is gathered and analyzed by the committee, the recommended compensation package for the President is presented to the full Board for approval. The process for determining the compensation grade levels for the WVUS senior leadership team of World Vision is managed by the World Vision US' Compensation Manager. All senior leadership positions are evaluated and matched to market data of both forprofit and nonprofit organizations where similar positions exist. The President approves the specific salary of the COO, CFO, and Senior Vice President of Human Resources within the appropriate grade level and within WVUS salary administration guidelines based upon recommendation of the Compensation Manager and Compensation Grading Committee. The COO and CFO are responsible to approve the grade levels as well as specific salary amounts for the senior leadership team members who report up to them in accordance with WVUS salary administration guidelines and based on the recommendation of the Compensation Manager and Compensation Grading Committee. In addition, periodic audits and reviews are conducted utilizing an outside consultant to validate that compensation levels of the senior leadership team are consistent with our compensation philosophy and current market data.
