AMENDMENT OF THE ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
Of
The Mustard Seed Foundation
December 14, 2015

Whereas pursuant to District of Columbia Non-Profit Corporation Act, §29-408.03 Amendment of Articles of Membership Corporation, the Board of Directors adopted an amendment to the Articles of Incorporation of The Mustard Seed Foundation (hereafter "The Foundation") at the Board of Directors meeting on April 22, 2015, at which a quorum was present, and sent it to the Foundation's Members with a recommendation for approval;

Whereas, the Directors, acting in their capacity as Members at a meeting of The Foundation on December 14, 2015, at which a quorum was present by a vote of five in favor of the Amendment and none opposed to the Amendment, approved the following amendment to the Charter of The Foundation.

1. Article Fourth shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

"The Corporation shall have no members."

2. Article Fifth shall be deleted in its entirety.

3. Article Sixth shall be deleted in its entirety and replaced by the following:

"The Directors of the Corporation shall be elected as determined by the By-Laws, provided, however, that failure to elect directors at the time designated therefor shall not work any forfeiture or dissolution of the Corporation."

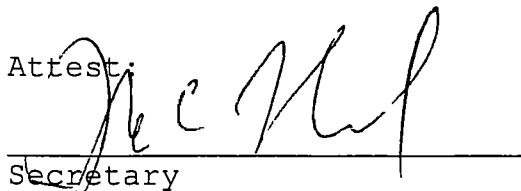
4. The second sentence of Article Seventh shall be amended as follows:

"None of the property, funds or other assets of the Corporation, upon dissolution or otherwise, shall ever revert to, or be distributed to its directors or officers, or any of them either directly or indirectly, but in case of dissolution shall be distributed to an organized charity to be chosen by vote of the directors of the Corporation, provided that such organization is exempted from federal taxation under Section 501 (c) (3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (or similar exemption statutes hereinafter enacted)."

5. In all other respects, the Directors ratify and confirm all other provisions of the Articles of Incorporation of The Mustard Seed Foundation as granted by the District of Columbia Department of Consumer and Regulatory Affairs on December 22, 1986.

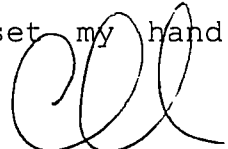

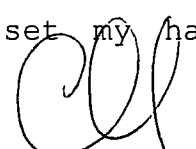
