	spectators in the "Palestine Pitch" arena in Tel al-Sultan, Rafah. The Tournament for Athletes with Disabilities helps connect those

This annual accounting audit is written, signed, and given directly to the board of directors with the opportunity for board members to ask questions. In addition, to educate the public about the economy of the Middle East and to support Palestinian business, we often sell olive oil, art, food, and embroidery made by small farmers and individuals in the Middle East and sold on a fair trade basis. We also carry books related to peace and justice issues. Most sales are made away from the foundation's office by unpaid volunteers. While the gross profit from this activity (\$9,023) is above \$1,000, the activity is exempt from tax both because it is related to the foundation's exempt purpose and because the sales are substantially conducted by unpaid volunteers. "An unrelated trade or business does not include a trade or business: 1. In which substantially all the work is done. for the organization without compensation..."
