



Regardless of any fiduciary relationship with any healthcare provider (licensed clinical practitioner, vendor, educational institution, payer, outside resource agency, etc.), the hospital and its representative staff (including medical staff), will strive to provide optimum care to patients following appropriate utilization of resources standards. Care provided to patients will not be dependent upon financial relationships or fiduciary responsibilities a Tests, studies, treatments or procedures deemed usual and r outrie in the diagnosis, management or treatment of disease processes, as standard in the healthcare community, will not be withheld from any patient (unless the patient exercises his/her patient right to refuse treatment) b. Any healthcare provider who feels there is a conflict of interest in patient management and their relationships with the facility, mus t contact administration and notify the Chief Executive Officer immediately. E. Discussion at the administrative level will be initiated, whereby problem resolution will be the pri mary goal. In the interim, the Chief of the service/department with jurisdiction over the healthcare provide
