Utility, fuel, rent, and education assisstance are all paid by check on the applicant's behalf to local creditors. Food assistance is perishable, non-perishable and frozen foods that are given directly to the

applicant. We maintain supermarket style food shelves from which we distribute the food. We measure the value of food distributions by pricing all goods with reference to retail food prices in

southeastern Vermont markets

All assistance is logged on a digital spreadsheet to show number of recipients and dollar value of assistance and is kept with the paper applications for at least three years

All funds are distributed from a checking account maintained by the treasurer and the executive director. A summary of grants distributed is given to each town that we serve for printing in their

annual town report.
