#### 2) Humanitarian Medical Assistance: \$11,384

We expanded our portfolio of medical services to include a selection of procedures like hernia repair, biopsies, laparoscopic diagnoses, orthopedic, obstetric, pediatric, and oncological interventions for low income patients who can no longer count on the public health system. In 2016, we were able to repair 160 hernias, and facilitate a small number of cesarean sections, oncological and orthopedic interventions, diagnoses and biopsies as well. We also offer CAT scans, ear-nose-throat, ophthalmological, pediatric and other consultations, when these services fail to respond in the public sector.

### 3) Brito Community Center and Rural Education: \$2,641

Our community center is the base of our rural programs, and houses a small educational computer center, with a small primary and high school library. The center includes scholarships for up to 60 rural high school students and 20 community college students who have graduated in our high school program. We also offer subsidized school supplies to low-income rural families at the center and at two other nearby locations. We assist the remote State primary through high school with seven teachers and 100+ students and the nearby rural kindergarten that we founded with the State in 2001. We have a small urban computer center with Internet for our rural scholarship students, which is also used by other low income urban and rural students. This program is now primarily funded through local revenue in Venezuela to our sister (independent) Fundación ServYr, and supplemented by this small amount of assistance from our Turimiquire funds.

#### 4) Rural Assistance and Sustainable Development, Eco-Agriculture: \$1,739

This hands-on directed assistance applies to approximately 80 families, benefiting more then 400 family members in all, with a small model farm offering community participation in sustainable land use and ecoagriculture, introduction of new fruit and other tree crops, alternative (solar) energy and water resource projects, housing and infrastructure assistance, family emergencies and micro enterprise. This program is now primarily funded through local revenue in Venezuela to our sister (independent) Fundación ServYr, and supplemented by this small amount of assistance from our Turimiquire funds.

The complex and unpredictable currency control system which the Venezuelan government exercises, leads to calculating and paying the actual costs in dollars after all expenses are summed up in the local currency and converted at the end of the year. Clinic and various program expenses accumulated over the entire year are often not completely accounted and paid until the first and second quarters of the following year.
