The Boston Scientific Foundation also offers Pete Nicholas Scholarships. The Pete Nicholas scholarship provides awards up to \$5,000 a year for a maximum of 4 years for undergraduate studies, or two years for associate degrees

The 2017 Boston Scientific Foundation

Scholarship on-line form is used for both scholarships. Students applying to the Pete Nicholas Scholarship are required to

- a Submit a Boston Scientific Foundation application online, including all required documents listed above, by the annual deadline in April
- b The selection criteria set forth in the Boston Scientific Foundation Scholarship applies to the Pete Nicholas Scholarship, however students are required to submit an additional separate-essay.
- c. No more than 3 students will be awarded a Pete Nicholas Scholarship each academic year.

Scholarship submission deadline:

Applications are considered on an annual basis. For example, submission deadline for 2017 Scholarship Program is April 28, 2017 An independent review committee is convened each year to select scholarship recipients

Eligibility guidelines:

The Boston Scientific Employee Scholarship Program seeks to improve educational opportunities and encourage children of Boston Scientific employees to realize their full potential. For purposes of this program, the term employees refers to "parents". "Parents" includes each individual who (i) is a natural or adoptive parent, step-parent, or legal guardian of the applicant and (ii) is financially responsible for the applicant. The term "parent" also includes the spouse or domestic partner of a parent of the applicant if that spouse or domestic partner is financially responsible for the applicant.

Academic achievement, financial need, citizenship, leadership qualities, general promise and the geographic location of qualified applicants will all be considered when determining scholarship awards. Pursuant to the requirements of the Boston Scientific Foundation by-laws, as approved by the IRS, only college bound children of US-Based Boston Scientific Employees are eligible to apply.

The number of scholarships awarded shall be equal to or less than 25 percent (25%) of the number of eligible candidates in the applicant pool, in accordance with IRS requirements.
