THE JOAN MITCHELL CENTER

THE FOUNDATION IS CURRENTLY DEVELOPING THE JOAN MITCHELL CENTER IN NEW ORLEANS, WHICH WILL BE AN ARTIST IN RESIDENCE (AIR) PROGRAM. THE PROGRAM WILL ALLOW FOR APPROXIMATELY 8 (EIGHT) ARTISTS AT A TIME TO BE IN RESIDENCE FOR STAYS RANGING IN LENGTH FROM A FEW WEEKS TO A FEW MONTHS. OF THE PROGRAM ARE CURRENTLY BEING FINALIZED. THE AIR PROGRAM WILL POTENTIALLY SERVE APPROXIMATELY 24 TO 50 (TWENTY FOUR TO FIFTY) VISUAL ARTISTS A YEAR. ADDITIONALLY ARTISTS ATTENDING THE RESIDENCY WILL RECEIVE A GRANT STIPEND TO COVER ART MATERIALS AND TRAVEL EXPENSES AS A WAY TO HELP FACILITATE THEIR PARTICIPATION.
